Round Rutland Run Sunday September 1st 2024





Uppingham Hopper – Do You Support It?

There are many ways for residents to support the Uppingham Hopper bus which runs Monday to Friday from 10am and 4pm.

Some folk use it regularly to go to the shops or the surgery or the garden centre. Some use it as a connecting bus to get to Oakham or Corby via the RF1 service bus. Others don't feel the need to use it yet as they can still drive, but generously make a regular donation to ensure its continuity.

Increasingly the bus is being booked evenings and weekends to take resident groups to the theatre, cinema or a rugby game. It has ferried Uppingham families to special events and supported numerous young people with journeys to a wide range of sporting and cultural events.
